

# COVID-19 Updated Infected Situation in Morioka City [July 29]

## About COVID-19 Infected Patient

Today, July 29 2020, the city confirmed the first case of COVID-19 patient in Morioka city. Hereafter, Morioka City Health Center will proceed with health observation of the patient as well as proactive epidemiological survey including the patient's close contacts.

## About the Patient

1. Age: 40s
2. Gender: Male
3. Residence: Morioka City
4. Symptoms: discomfort in the throat, cough
5. Recent movements and actions of the patient

### Movements / Actions

| Wednesday, July 22                  | He went to a camp site in Kanto region by his own car and meet up with 3 friends.   |
| Thursday, July 23 – Sunday, July 26 | Stayed in the camp site (4 of them stayed in the same tent)   |
| Sunday, July 26                     | He left the camp site and drove back home.<br>On his way home, he stopped at service area on a highway 3 times to eat and use bathroom.<br>He went to supermarket for shopping. ※   |
| Monday, July 27                     | He went to work. (He was wearing a mask during work.)<br>He had lunch at restaurant. ※  |
| Tuesday, July 28                    | He went to work. (He was wearing a mask during work.)<br>He had lunch at restaurant. ※<br>He reported that he was informed one of his friends who were with him during camping was infected with COVID-19 to his work place and went home.<br>He consulted with Morioka City Returnees and Potential Contacts Center. |
| Wednesday, July 29                  | At outpatient facility for returnees and potential contacts, he was tested positive by PCR.   |

6. ※There were no close contacts with others at any places he stopped by.  
※The patient's family members did not have close contact with the patient.
7. People who had close contact with the patient.

Morioka Health Center's investigation is on progress. No close contact confirmed except in his work place.

#### 8. Others

The patient consulted with outpatient medical facility for returnees and potential contacts on Wednesday, July 29 and PCR tested positive. Today, the patient was hospitalized in medical institutions for infectious diseases.
